Including the above newly reported cases, New Mexico has now had a total of 35 positive tests for COVID-19:

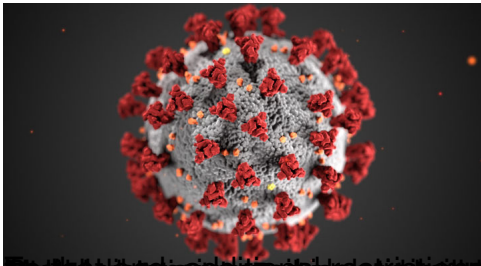
- □ Bernalillo County: 20
