SANTA FE – New Mexico state health officials announced seven additional positive tests for COVID-19 on March 18.

Per the state Department of Health, the most recent cases are:

- Difference Four people in Bernalillo County
- One person in San Miguel County
- Two people in Santa Fe County

Including the above newly reported cases, New Mexico has now had a total of 35 positive tests for COVID-19:

- Bernalillo County: 20
- Sandoval County: 4
- San Miguel County: 1
- Santa Fe County: 7
- DDD Socorro County: 2
- Taos County: 1

The Department of Health has detected community spread. The agency reports that given the infectious nature of the virus, it is likely other residents are infected but yet to be tested or confirmed positive.
