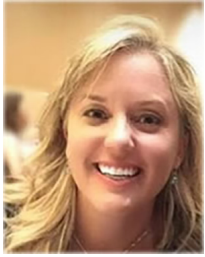


UNM-Gallup assistant professor wins Online Teacher of the Year
